


Albin Vega

Her sailing qualities and comfort have made her famous and sought after.


Today throughout the world there are nearly 3500 examples.


Garbage bin behind sliding door.

Volvo Penta diesel — 13 hp. The engine is rubber mounted and located in a well insulated engine compartment.





Long keel giving greater directional stability, only 1.17 m (3'10") draft.
