



Albin Marin has a range of eight boats to meet the needs of most yachtsmen. Albin 57 is a sailing boat which can easily be towed on the trailer behind your car, Albin Viggen is a sailing boat for the "addicted", Albin Vega is the classical Albin boat, Albin 79 is the swift 1/4 tonner, Albin Ballad is the family ocean racer, Albin 25 is the motor boat for the family man, Albin 30 is the representative motor boat and Albin 82 MS is a true motor sailer.



















This is an entirely new design approach for small sailing boats. Although 5.7 metres long, she has four 2-metre bunks below deck. Owing to the drop keel, the draught can be reduced from 1.30 m to no more than 0.60 m. Its design renders the Albin 57 eminently suitable for towing on a trailer.



The Viggen is a roomy allround sailer, particularly designed for those who wish to sail with their family. Her performance under sail will leave little to desire, particularly on a longer journey.







The 1/4 tonner for those who long for thoroughbread performance. The inboard engine is located well forward, and this contributes her fine balance when the crew is in the cockpit. The Swedish designer Rolf Magnusson has successfully combined features which appeal to the racing enthusiast with the demands of the family man, in a boat with attractive lines.


ALBIN VEGA




